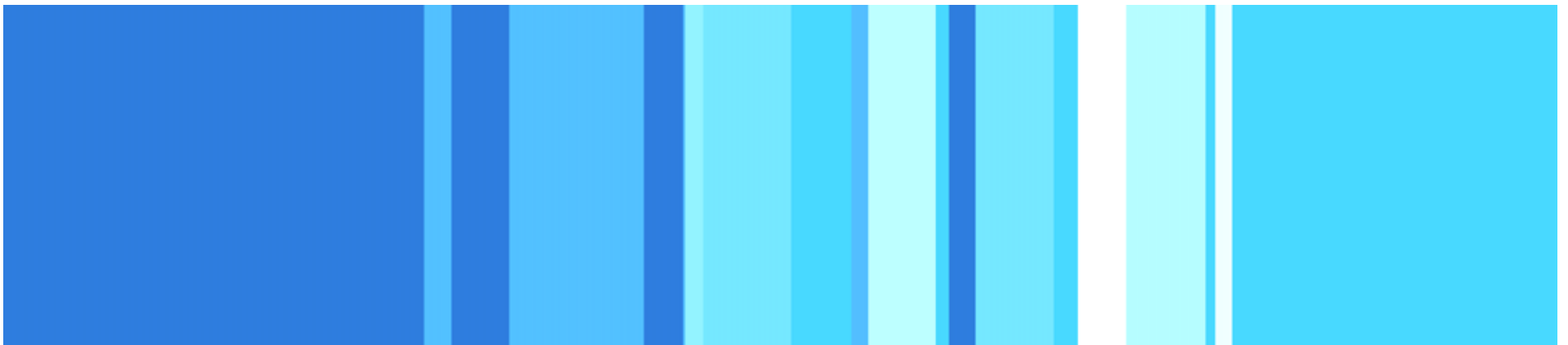


August 2006—Minnesota Post-Secondary Education Enrollment, Fall 2005



Basic Data Series 2005

Part 1. Five-year Summaries

Part 1 summarizes headcount enrollments at Minnesota post-secondary institutions during the past five years:

- ***Five-year Summary of Total Headcount*** presents the total number of individuals enrolled the tenth day of classes for fall terms 2001 through 2005, or the institution's official fall reporting date. The percent change columns compare fall 2005 enrollment to fall 2001 and fall 2004.
- ***Five-year Summary of Full-time and Part-time Enrollment*** presents the distribution of total headcount by enrollment status. The table also displays each institution's full-time/part-time ratios for 2001 and 2005. A full-time student is registered for credit hours, course load, or other required activity amounting to at least 75 percent of the normal full-time load during an academic term. Part-time students are registered for less than 75 percent of the normal full-time load.
- ***Five-year Summary of Enrollment by Gender*** presents the distribution of men and women for each institution from 2001 through 2005. Students whose gender was not known are not tabulated.

For each type of post-secondary institution, residence is tabulated in two different ways:

- The **County of Residence** is presented for new entering students who are Minnesota residents only, along with their full-time or part-time enrollment status and gender.
- **Students by Place of Residence** by level of study are presented for all students. For all new entering students, their full-time or part-time enrollment status and gender are also presented.

Note: Total Undergraduate Students includes new entering students.
