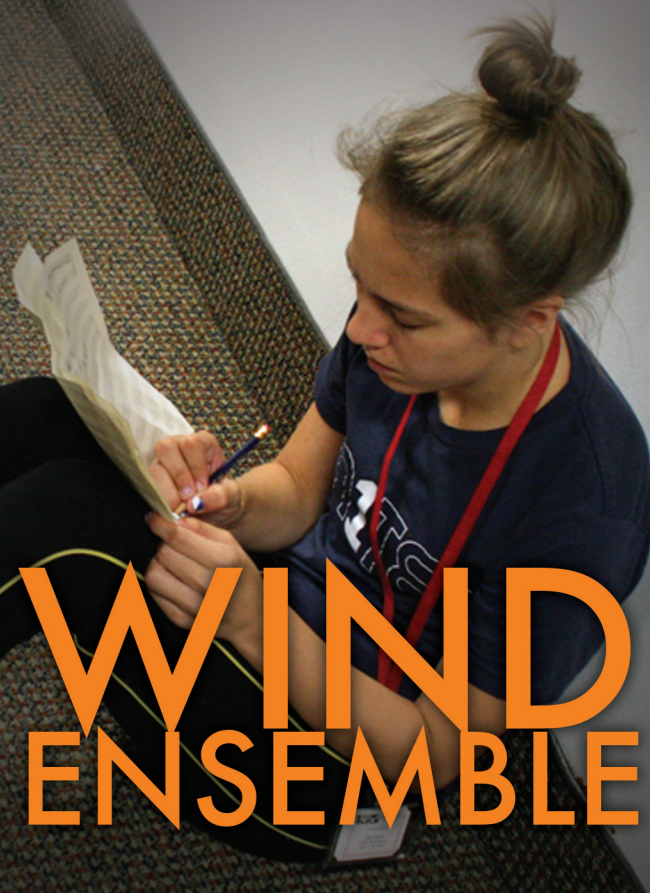
2015 JUNIOR COMPOSERS OPPORTUNITIES

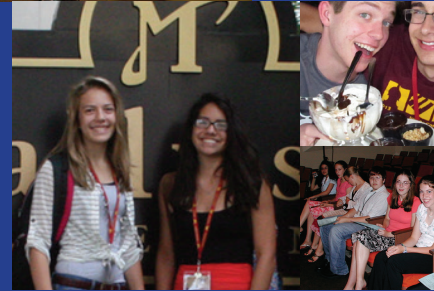
