Student may apply for admission to SCTCC. The application deadline is two weeks before the start of given semester (including summer). College entrance testing (Accuplacer) may be waived if the student has sufficient coursework completed to meet the exemption criteria.

Once accepted to the college, an official transcript is required to complete final transfer evaluation and processing in the Records and Registration Office.
