Waive the application fee for all applicants. Application review by admissions, registrar and program director will occur within three business days. Some programs may take longer to review.

- Bachelor Completion Applicants (students in BS Completion programs or Associate Degree programs who want to pursue a BS degree):
 - Complete online application form
 - Submit all official* transcripts issued to Saint Mary's University of Minnesota from all previous institutions attended with a minimum of 30 semester credits with a basic English composition course. *Unofficial transcripts will be accepted if official are not readily available at the time of application.
- Graduate Program Applicants:

- Complete online application form
 - Complete personal statement
 - Submit all official* transcripts issued to Saint Mary's University of Minnesota from all previous institutions attended. *Unofficial transcripts will be accepted if official are not readily available at the time of application.
 - Waive letters of references and resume if in good standing at previous institution (minimum 3.0 GPA). Some programs may require letters of reference and résumé.
- Doctoral Program Applicants:
 - Follow the standard admissions process
 - *Unofficial transcripts will be accepted if official are not readily available at the time of application.

Students may be admitted conditionally if they do not meet all the academic requirements of their academic program.

Degree-seeking students who are enrolled at least half-time may be eligible for financial aid.
