Bachelor degrees: Students must earn a "C" or better in comparable classes. Cumulative GPA must be at least 2.0. Students must complete 25% of degree at TU (10 classes)

Master degrees: Students must earn a "C" or better in comparable classes. Cumulative GPA must be 3.0 or higher. Students must complete 30% of degree at TU (depending on program length between 3 and 7 courses). Specific majors may have additional requirements.

Division Chairs are reviewing Argosy transcripts to determine comparable coursework. If student has syllabi, that is helpful, but not required.

Describe your transfer admission requirements, review process and timeline, including incentives for Argosy students:

Undergraduate students:

Students must complete an application for admission and provide official transcripts from all previous institutions. Undergraduate students must have a 2.0 CGPA. Graduate students must have a 3.0 CGPA.

Medical Laboratory Science program – candidates must hold a MLT or CLT certification or completed an associate degree from a NAACLS accredited program.

RN-BSN program – candidates must hold an unrestricted RN license.

Graduate students:

Graduate students must have a 3.0 CGPA.

Official transcript from institution granting their bachelor's degree and official graduate transcript.

Acceptance and transcript evaluations provided once all official transcripts received.

Waive application fee for Argosy students.
