Student wishing to transfer will need to fill out the appropriate application form—transfer application for undergraduate students and the program-specific application for any graduate programs.

Undergraduate students: apart from the application, student needs to submit all post-secondary transcripts and a Transfer Student Verification Form which will be sent to a recommender of the student's choosing at their most recent institution. Some undergraduate programs (e.g.

Sonography, Nuclear Medicine, Nursing) have an additional supplemental application form that will be provided to the student once they have completed the transfer form.

Graduate programs: Each graduate program has its own admission requirements that will be provided in writing to the student once they submit their application form.

Describe your transfer admission requirements, review process and timeline, including incentives for Argosy students:

Undergraduate: Transfer students need to carry a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher, and have a minimum of 12 transferable credit hours.

Graduate: Students looking to pursue a graduate program will need to meet the requirements for the graduate program as stated on our website at <u>www.findlay.edu</u>.

Timeline: UF utilizes rolling enrollment process for most of our programs, so as soon as the application and all required admissions materials are submitted, an admissions decision will be made within a few days.

Incentives: The sonography program has offered to waive their \$50 application fee for their supplemental application for Argosy students.

Undergraduate: Merit-based scholarships may be available for degree-seeking transfer students. Argosy students will be offered an additional scholarship of \$1000.
