Transfer students may apply via our <u>Adult Undergraduate application process</u>. Applications will be reviewed for admittance upon receipt of all official collegiate transcripts. (An official high school transcript is required if transferring less than 60 collegiate credits).

Students should expect an admittance decision within 2-weeks of submitting an application and all supplemental documents.
