These institutions have more students who are part-time adults who are not new entering students or who are enrolled in two-year programs.

\*\*These four institutions were combined as each had less than 10 students in the cohort for tracking bachelor's degree graduation rates.

Graduation rates are calculated for students who received a bachelor's degree within six years at the same institution. Note: not all students at the institution are tracked for these rates. Students who have already attended another postsecondary institution, or who began their studies on a part-time basis, are not tracked for this rate.
