## National Enrollment Landscape

National Student Clearinghouse Current Term Enrollment Estimates:

- Overall enrollment declined 2.5 percent nationally in fall 2020 and declined 2.7 percent in fall 2021, roughly twice the rate of enrollment decline reported in fall 2019
- Undergraduate enrollment declined 3.6 percent in fall 2020 while graduate enrollment increased
- The public 2-year sector saw the largest percent declines of any sector in fall 2020 and spring 2021

## Minnesota Enrollment Landscape

- Enrollment decline in fall 2020 for Minnesota State 2-year colleges (-5.3%) was smaller than public 2-years nationally (-10.1%)
- All sectors saw declines in fall 2020 except Private For-Profit Online Only
- Declines across all sectors in fall 2021 except the University of Minnesota Twin Cities
