

fall 2011 to fall 2021




#### Aggregate First-year & Transfer Enrollment,




# Share of students who were Students of Color & Native American, fall 2011 to fall 2021

Public 4-years: 24%


Private nonprofits: 18%


## Share of Undergraduates who were Pell Grant Recipients, 2001-02 to 2021-22

#### Fall 2020 MN Enrollment

- 7% decline in enrollment of students 19 and under
- 8% decline in enrollment of firstyear students of color and Native American students
- 10% decline in new transfer enrollment
- 5% decline in first-generation undergraduate student enrollment
