Activities After Learner Lifespan Report

- Four subgroups (Financial Aid & Literacy, Dual Credit/Exam Based Credit, Credentials of Value, Data Use & Capacity) reviewed work so far and developed specific recommendations
- Some of those recommendations have been executed but many more remain incomplete
- We must prioritize the remaining work according to our shared values
- To do that, we must agree on values that maximize benefit to our agencies and move the work forward

Where the Workgroups Are

- Financial Aid & Literacy (FAL) gave an Action Plan in Sept 2021, update in Sept 2022
- Data Use & Capacity (DUC) gave recommendations in Sept 2021
- Credentials of Value (COV) gave recommendations in Nov 2021
- Dual Credit/Exam Based Credit (DCEBC) gave recommendations in Nov 2021

Guiding North Star

Achieving the State of Minnesota's Post-secondary Attainment Goal:

Increase the proportion of Minnesota adults age 25-44 who have attained a post-secondary certificate, diploma, or degree to **70%** by 2025, **within each racial/ethnic group**
