

Applying for the Student Teacher Grants through the MNAid Student Portal

1. Navigate to the Student Portal at [Student Portal - Login \(guarantorsolutions.com\)](http://guarantorsolutions.com)
2. Click on the text “If this is your first time...” to create an account. If you already have an account, log in and skip to #7.

3. Create a username and enter the information for all required fields. Ensure that you are entering your name, SSN and date of birth correctly. The system will use that information to match your account to the FAFSA on file for you.




