Notes: The "Race/Ethnicity Total" column equals the sum of the five racial/ethnic group columns. The "Race/Ethnicity Total" column will not equal the "Public Total" column in the projected years and also may not for the years in which local education agencies' reported data reflect additional racial/ethnic groups. Data reported as "Hawaiian/Pacific Islander" were added to "Asian/Pacific Islander" and data reported as "Two or more Races" were proportionally distributed to the four race categories. Page B-1 shows the full Census name for this metropolitan statistical area. Adjustments to the restricted-use data and how the metropolitan areas were defined are detailed in Appendix C: Technical Information. Values were rounded to the nearest 10 and values less than 10 were suppressed, to avoid disclosure of individuals, in keeping with U.S. Department of Education guidance about reporting data based on restricted-use data.
