Mentor system which pairs a Minnesota School of Cosmetology student with a Regency student - to provide extra support to Regency students in getting acclimated to our campus.

Students will attend an informative orientation prior to beginning classes.

Students will begin by learning everything specific to Minnesota School of Cosmetology campus structure and our educational delivery to ensure they feel comfortable. This includes but is not limited to Minnesota School of Cosmetology:

- Product lines used
- Techniques we teach – including but not limited to hair color, haircutting, skin care, nails, relaxers, perming etc.

During the transition period students will be tested on their skill level. We will use their results to make sure they receive the appropriate training wherever it's needed.

If students reach 1550 hours and are not licensure ready students will continue their education with Minnesota School of Cosmetology at no additional cost.
