## Introduction

This report contains data on the number and dollar amounts of Minnesota State Grants received by Minnesota undergraduates for Fiscal Year 2003 (academic year 2002-2003). Minnesota State Grants are coordinated with Federal Pell Grants, so the tables and graphs also show combined Federal Pell and State Grant awards to State Grant recipients. In addition, since ability to pay is calculated based on income and assets, data are reported by the adjusted gross income of the student's family.

The report also includes information on three categories of student characteristics that affect State Grant awards:

- **Family Status:** Recipients are classified by family status. Each category of family has its ability to pay assessed differently:
  - Dependent students (usually students less than 24 years old who were not married and not supporting their own children)
  - Married independent students with children
  - Unmarried independent students with children
  - Married independent students without children
  - Single independent students (without children)
  
- **Attendance Strategy:** The report classifies recipients by the number of course credits for which they registered. The registration load chosen by the student affects the price of attendance used in calculating Minnesota State Grant awards. The report classified State Grant recipients by two attendance strategies:
  - Recipients who registered for fewer than 30 credits during Fiscal Year 2003.
    - These students are also called part-time or part-year students.<sup>1</sup>
  - Recipients who registered for at least 30 credits during Fiscal Year 2003.
    - These students are also called full-time, full-year students.
  
- **Post-Secondary Institution Choice:** The institution students chose to attend determined the price of attendance used in calculating Minnesota State Grants. For purposes of State Grant eligibility, students attending four-year institutions were subject to a maximum recognized tuition and fees of \$8,983. Students attending two-year institutions were subject to a maximum recognized tuition and fees of \$6,913. Institutions are grouped into the five sectors listed below. See pages 87-89 for a list of the institutions in each sector.
  - MnSCU two-year colleges
  - Minnesota private two-year (career) institutions - Institutions offering only programs that can be completed in two years of full-time study or less.
  - MnSCU four-year universities
  - University of Minnesota

1 The Minnesota State Grant Program defines full-time attendance as a registration load of 15 semester credits (or the equivalent) per term. A registration load of at least 30 credits during Fiscal Year 2003 is equal to full-time, full-year attendance in this report.


- Minnesota private four-year institutions - Include liberal arts, religious, and for-profit career colleges that offered bachelor's degrees in Fiscal Year 2003.

The data in this report are based on the State Grant research data file as of October 2003. Totals may differ slightly from other documents published by the Minnesota Higher Education Services Office which are based on data captured at a different date.





### Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients






### Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients





## Minnesota State Grant Statistics: Recipients Applying as Dependent Students, Fiscal Year 2003


Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients





## Minnesota State Grant Statistics: Recipients Applying as Dependent Students, Registered for Fewer Than 30 Credits, Fiscal Year 2003


Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients





### Minnesota State Grant Statistics: Recipients Applying as Dependent Students, Registered for at Least 30 Credits, Fiscal Year 2003


**Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients**





## Minnesota State Grant Statistics: Married Students with Children, Applying as Independent Students, Fiscal Year 2003


Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients






Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients





## Minnesota State Grant Statistics: Married Students with Children, Applying as Independent Students, Registered for at Least 30 Credits, Fiscal Year 2003


Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients





### Minnesota State Grant Statistics: Unmarried Students with Children, Applying as Independent Students, Fiscal Year 2003


Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients






Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients






**Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients**





### Minnesota State Grant Statistics: Married Students with No Children, Applying as Independent Students, Fiscal Year 2003


Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients






Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients






Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients






Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients





### Minnesota State Grant Statistics: Single Independent Students, Registered for Fewer Than 30 Credits, Fiscal Year 2003







### Minnesota State Grant Statistics: Single Independent Students, Registered for at Least 30 Credits, Fiscal Year 2003


**Number of Minnesota State Grant Recipients**
