Subject: Mandatory Estimated State Grant Award Parameters for 2022-2023

Date: November 17, 2021

Based on a recommendation from MAFAA's State Grant Taskforce, the Office of Higher Education issues mandatory estimated Minnesota State Grant award parameters. All participating campuses should use the estimated award parameters until the OHE issues official 2022-2023 award parameters at the close of the 2022 legislative session. The rationale behind this recommendation was to ensure students would receive comparable State Grant award estimates from similarly priced institutions. Changes from 2021-2022 actual parameters are shown in red.
