

## Tuition and fees report should reflect:

- Weighted average tuition charged to a student taking 15 credits per term
  - For Minnesota State and U of M campuses, this is the standard resident tuition rate
  - Minnesota State institutions should use the separate guidance provided by Meghan Flores when calculating what to report for the 2022-2023 rates
  - For colleges with multiple tuition rates, the weighted average tuition rate
    - Multiply each program tuition rate by percentage of student populaton in program and add results for weighted average
    - Email the supporting calculation to Nancy Johnson in the State Grant Unit
- The per-credit tuition rate should reflect the actual per-credit rate, which is not always the term rate divided by 15 credits
- Mandatory general fees charged to a student taking 15 credits per term
  - Do not include fees for the purchase of items if the student retains ownership (rental fees are accepted if your school retains ownership)
  - Do not include refundable deposits or fees. or fees that can be waived
- Dollars and cents for each item and column (OHE will round the final result)
