

# Part 1. Five-year Summaries

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Part 1 contains the following five-year summaries of total headcount enrollments for Minnesota post-secondary institutions:

- ***Five-year Summary of Total Headcount*** presents the total number of individuals enrolled the tenth day of classes for fall terms 1993 through 1997. Until fall 1993, technical colleges and private career schools reported headcount enrollment for the quarter ending October 15. Starting in fall 1994, all technical colleges and private career schools with distinct academic terms are reporting tenth day fall data. The percent change columns compare fall 1997 enrollment to fall 1993 and fall 1996.
- ***Five-year Summary of Full-time and Part-time Enrollment*** presents the distribution of total headcount by enrollment status. The table also displays each institution's full-time/part-time ratios for 1993 and 1997. A full-time student is registered for credit hours, course load, or other required activity amounting to at least 75 percent of the normal full-time load during an academic term. Part-time students are registered for less than 75 percent of the normal full-time load.
- ***Five-year Summary of Male and Female Enrollment*** presents the distribution of male and female students for each institution from 1993 through 1997. Students whose gender was not known are not tabulated.
- ***Five-year Summary of Total New Entering Students*** presents total new entering students at each institution for fall 1993 through 1997. The percent change columns compare fall 1996 new entering student enrollments to fall 1993 and fall 1996.

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Data may vary from previously published series due to corrections made after the publication date.

Not all private career schools report headcount annually, which creates some difficulties in historical comparisons.

## Part 2. Residence

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The residence of students is summarized by type of post-secondary institution. The residence is the place the student identified as his or her residence at the time of admission to the post-secondary institution.

For each type of post-secondary institution, residence is tabulated in two different ways:

- ***The County of Residence*** is presented for new entering students who are Minnesota residents only, along with their full-time or part-time enrollment status and gender.
- ***Students by Place of Residence*** by level of study is presented for all students. For all new entering students, their full-time or part-time enrollment status and gender are also presented. Note: *Total Undergraduate Students* includes new entering students.

# Part 3. Participation in Post-Secondary Education

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Participation of high school graduates in post-secondary education is presented in three ways. These tables include only Minnesota residents who were reported as *new entering students* in fall 1997.

- **Participation Rates of 1997 Minnesota High School Graduates** by gender are presented for each institution. The participation rate is derived by dividing the number of reported 1997 high school graduates enrolled in each institution by the total number of Minnesota 1997 high school graduates.\* New entering students who did not report their year of high school graduation or gender are not included; therefore, the actual participation rate may be under represented.
- **Distribution of Minnesota New Entering Students by Year of High School Graduation** from 1994 through 1997 is presented for each institution. High school graduates from 1993 and earlier years are combined into one category. New entering students who did not report their year of high school graduation are not included.
- **Participation Ratios of New Entering Students Who Graduated from High School in 1997 to All 1997 Graduates** by county are calculated for each post-secondary system. Minnesota resident new entering students who graduated from high school in 1997 in each county are divided by the total number of high school graduates in 1997 from that county. (The method of calculating participation ratios has been changed from previous years when all new entering students were used regardless of the year they graduated from high school). New entering students who did not report their year of high school graduation are not included.

Data may vary from previously published series due to corrections made after the publication date.
