

Basic Data Series 2004 Summary Report



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About the Minnesota Office of Higher Education

The Minnesota Office of Higher Education is a cabinet-level state agency providing students with financial aid programs and information to help them gain access to post-secondary education. The agency serves as the state's clearinghouse for data, research and analysis on post-secondary enrollment, financial aid, finance and trends.

The Minnesota State Grant Program, which is administered by the agency, is a need-based tuition assistance program for Minnesota students. The agency oversees tuition reciprocity programs, a student loan program, Minnesota's 529 College Savings Program, licensing and an early awareness outreach initiative for youth. Through collaboration with systems and institutions, the agency assists in the development of the state's education technology infrastructure and shared library resources.

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
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Introduction

The Minnesota Office of Higher Education publishes reports on enrollments at Minnesota post-secondary institutions. Educational planners, policy makers and the public use the data for descriptive and research purposes.

Since 1983, this report has been generated from the Office of Higher Education's student enrollment record data base. The data base contains unit records for students enrolled during the fall in Minnesota's public and private post-secondary education institutions. Prior to 1983, the *Basic Data Series* was prepared from summary data that was supplied by individual post-secondary institutions. The first *Basic Data Series* was produced in 1974.

The *Basic Data Series* is comprised of four sections:

1) Five-year Summaries

Five-year enrollment summaries are presented for each post-secondary institution. Summarized enrollments include a total headcount, full-time and part-time, male and female, and new entering student enrollments.

2) Residence

The county of residence for Minnesota's new entering students is summarized for each system. Residency by state or foreign country is summarized by system for all students.

3) Distribution by Year of High School Graduation

The distribution of Minnesota new entering students by year of high school graduation is presented for each institution from 2000 to 2004.

4) Institution Enrollment Reports

Enrollment data are summarized by level of study, gender, and full-time or part-time attendance for each institution.

Technical Notes

Institutions are asked to provide unit records for students enrolled on the tenth day of fall term, or the institution's official fall reporting date. Institutions without distinct academic terms are asked to provide enrollments using the three-month period, July 15 through October 15, as a proxy for tenth day data.

Private post-secondary institutions are not required to report their student enrollment data, but many institutions do so voluntarily. Every effort is made to collect data from all post-secondary institutions that are eligible to participate in Minnesota's student financial aid programs.

The data in the *Basic Data Series* may differ from data that appear in preliminary fall headcount data posted on the Office of Higher Education Web site. Preliminary data are often based on a verbal headcount figure. The data that appear in the *Basic Data Series* and other reports are derived from actual unit record data received from post-secondary institutions containing 36 data elements on each individual student.

In some cases, the unit record data received for the databases differ from

the headcount figure that is used in the preliminary report. The main reasons are:

- Private institutions are not required to provide data for the databases, but a headcount is obtained when possible for the preliminary headcount report.
- The Minnesota State Colleges and Universities provide end-of-term data for the student enrollment database, but an early fall estimate for the preliminary headcount report.

Data may vary from previously published reports due to corrections made after the publication date.

Glossary

Academic Year — the period of time, typically from fall through spring, when institutions traditionally have conducted their instructional activity.

Community and Technical Colleges — are two-year institutions that are part of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities System. There are six community colleges, nine technical colleges, and 12 combined community and technical colleges offering general education and career-related associate degrees and shorter programs.

Credit-Based Instruction — organized instruction that is part of a major program of study in the technical colleges.

First Professional — professional school or program which requires at least two academic years of college work for entrance and a total of at least six years for a degree. Examples include chiropractic, dentistry, law, medicine, theology and veterinary medicine.

Foreign Student — a student whose residence was located outside the United States or its territories, or who was reported as a nonresident citizen in the United States on a temporary basis.

Full-time — registration for credit hours, course load, or other required activity, as defined by the institution, amounting to at least 75 percent of the normal full-time load during an academic term.

Graduate — a program of studies culminating in the attainment of a master's, specialist, or doctorate degree.

Headcount — the number of individuals enrolled at a post-secondary institution.

Hour-based Instruction — organized instruction that is not part of a major program of study in the state's public technical colleges.

New Entering Student — a student who is enrolled at a post-secondary institution for the first time and who previously has not been enrolled at another post-secondary institution, except as a secondary student. This category includes students who entered with advanced standing, through college credits earned before graduation from high school, performance on Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exams, or other measure.

Part-time — registration for credit hours, course load, or other required activity, as defined by the institution, amounting to less than 75 percent of the normal full-time load during an academic term.

Private Career Schools — are predominately for-profit institutions offering only career specific certificates, diplomas, and degrees. While institutions in this group offer mostly programs that can be completed in two years or less, some institutions offer limited career specific bachelor's degrees, and/or graduate programs in addition to their shorter programs.

Programs are offered predominantly in the following fields of study:

- Allied Health and Health Services
- Business, Management and Marketing
- Communication and Communication Technologies
- Computer and Information Sciences
- Design and Applied Arts
- Legal Support Services
- Personal and Culinary Services
- Transportation, Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Services

Private Colleges and Universities — are predominately not-for-profit four-year liberal arts or religious institutions. In addition to providing undergraduate education, some private colleges offer professional education and graduate degree programs in certain fields.

Private Graduate and Professional Schools — institutions that predominately offer specialized graduate or first professional programs. In some cases, limited undergraduate programs may also be offered. These institutions may be for-profit or not-for-profit. A first professional program requires completion of a program that is necessary to practice in the profession; at least two years of college work prior to entering the program; and a total of at least six academic years of college work to complete the program. First professional degrees may be awarded in the following 10 fields:

- Chiropractic
- Dentistry
- Law
- Medicine
- Optometry
- Osteopathic Medicine
- Pharmacy
- Podiatry
- Theology
- Veterinary Medicine

Racial/Ethnic Background — the group as reported by the student. This is the group with which the student identifies. The reporting options are: American Indian or Alaskan Native; Asian or Pacific Islanders; Black, non-Hispanic; White, non-Hispanic; or unavailable.

Residence — the place the student identifies as his or her address at the time of application for admission to the post-secondary institution.

Secondary Student — a student who is concurrently enrolled in high school and a post-secondary institution.

State Universities — are four-year comprehensive institutions that are part of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities System. There are seven state universities offering bachelor's degrees and graduate programs leading to master's and advanced degrees.

Unclassified Graduate/Professional — a student enrolled for graduate credit whose status as a graduate or professional school student has not been specified.

Unclassified Undergraduate — student enrolled for undergraduate credit whose specific class level cannot be specified.

University of Minnesota — comprises four campuses. The Twin Cities campus is the state's land-grant research university, offering bachelor's degrees, professional education, and graduate education through the doctorate. The Morris campus offers an undergraduate liberal arts curriculum. The Crookston campus focuses on career and technology based undergraduate programs. The Duluth campus offers a broad undergraduate and graduate curriculum.

Part 1. Five-year Summaries

Part one summarizes headcount enrollments at Minnesota post-secondary institutions during the past five years:

- ***Five-year Summary of Total Headcount*** presents the total number of individuals enrolled the tenth day of classes for fall terms 2000 through 2004, or the institution's official fall reporting date. The percent change columns compare fall 2004 enrollment to fall 2000 and fall 2003.
- ***Five-year Summary of Full-time and Part-time Enrollment*** presents the distribution of total headcount by enrollment status. The table also displays each institution's full-time/part-time ratios for 2000 and 2004. A full-time student is registered for credit hours, course load, or other required activity amounting to at least 75 percent of the normal full-time load during an academic term. Part-time students are registered for less than 75 percent of the normal full-time load.
- ***Five-year Summary of Male and Female Enrollment*** presents the distribution of male and female students for each institution from 2000 through 2004. Students whose gender was not known are not tabulated.

Part 2. Residence
